What to include in your resume

- Your full name
- Your date of birth
- Your address
- Your phone number
- Your email address

- Any experience you may have had in that field
- Hobbies or skills
- Awards you have received
- Activities and/or sports you have been involved in at school or in the community (Be sure you say how long you participated and any positions of leadership you have held)
- Enrichment experiences
- Volunteer experience
- Jobs you have had and the dates

Optional:

- Extenuating/unusual circumstances
- Ethnicity
- # of siblings
- Whether you're the first one in your family to go to college
